Application for the scholarship should include the following:

- 1. The application form
- 2. A description of your project (2-3 pages, typed, double spaced) including its short term (for the summer) and long term objectives
- 3. A budget, including costs of travel, lodging and meals
- 4. A statement of support from a faculty member who will supervise the project
- 5. An official Duke transcript
- 6. Please note that grant recipients working with human subjects will need a check with the Office of Research Support to see if their project needs IRB approval. See http://www.ors.duke.edu/undergraduate-research for information.
